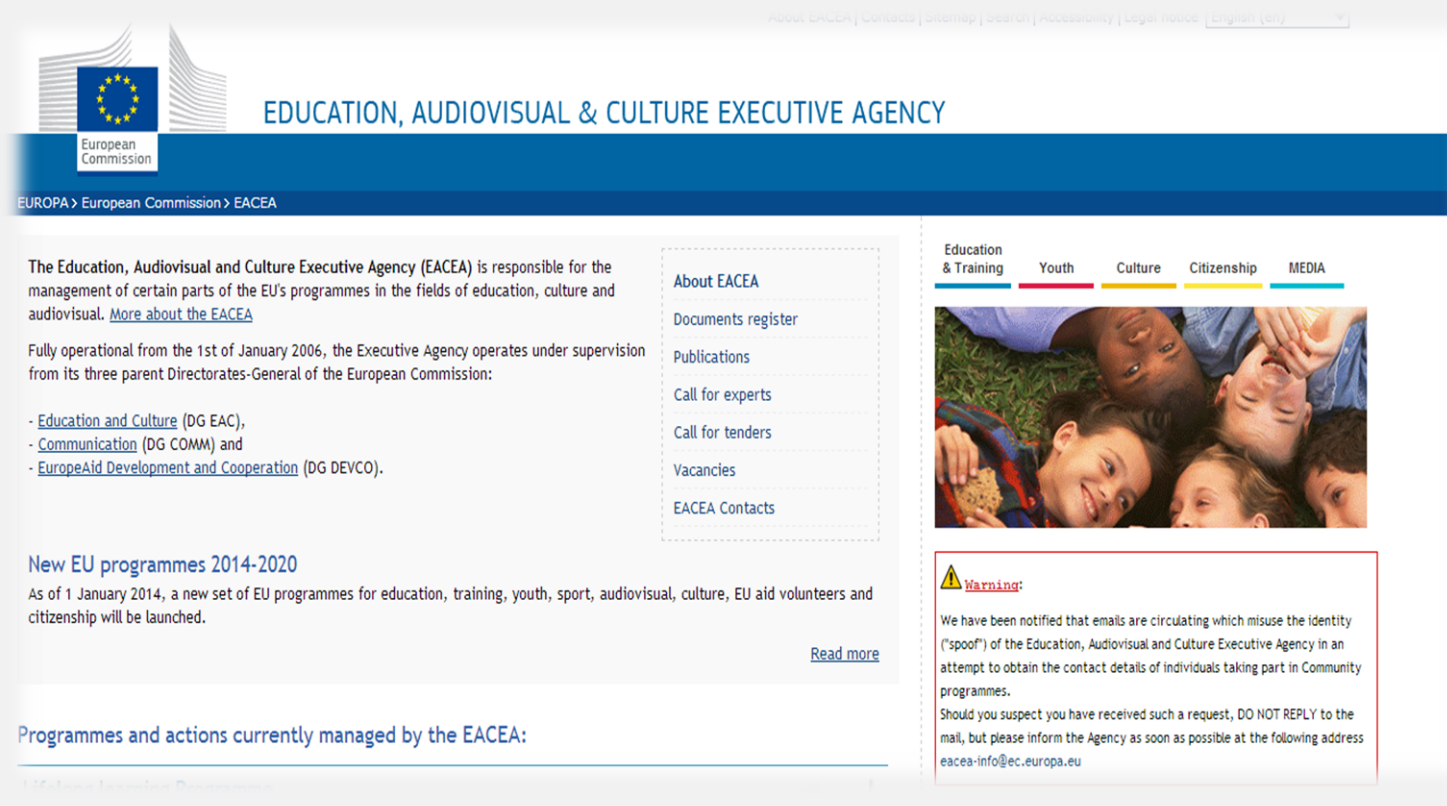

Europe has a challenging agenda for the next seven years, with serious issues at stake. With decisions and policies needed on issues ranging from economic growth, security and Europe's role in the world, it is now more important than ever for citizens to take part in discussions and help shape policies. The Proposal for a COUNCIL REGULATION establishing for the period 2014-2020 the programme "Europe for Citizens" has been adopted by the College on 14.12.2011.

The general objective of the future programme will be to "strengthen remembrance and enhance capacity for civic participation at the Union level". To this, the programme would contribute by developing citizens' organisations' capacity to engage citizens in the democratic life of the Union.

The specific objectives proposed would comprise:

- Stimulate debate, reflection and networking on remembrance, the Union's history, identity and aim;
- Develop citizens' understanding of the Union policy making-process and promote

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE ORGANIZATION	
Location	Culleredo is a Spanish municipality, belonging to the province of A Coruña in the Autonomous Community of Galicia.
	This municipality has an extension of 68.2 km ² which are integrated in the 11 parishes. Culleredo is part of the Metropolitan Area of A Coruña along with other nine municipalities.
	Due to its geographical characteristics, we might say that Culleredo represents, generally speaking, a hinterland for A Coruña, the biggest city of the region and at the same time, the center of the economic and administrative life of the area.
	It is also important to mention the combination of the rural and urban areas in the Culleredo Municipality. Due to the fact that Culleredo is strongly influenced by its proximity to A Coruña, the neighbouring parishes to the city are highly urbanized; two of them providing to the Municipality about 16.500 inhabitants (Riús 9.500 inhabitants and O Burgo 7.000), which represent almost 60% of the total population of Culleredo. In the first group, people in general are dedicated to the secondary sector; while in the second one, we can emphasize the institutional sector (Culleredo is the capital of the Municipality) and the livestock sector.

- Pon a prueba tu borrador de aplicación con personas ajenas a la asociación.
